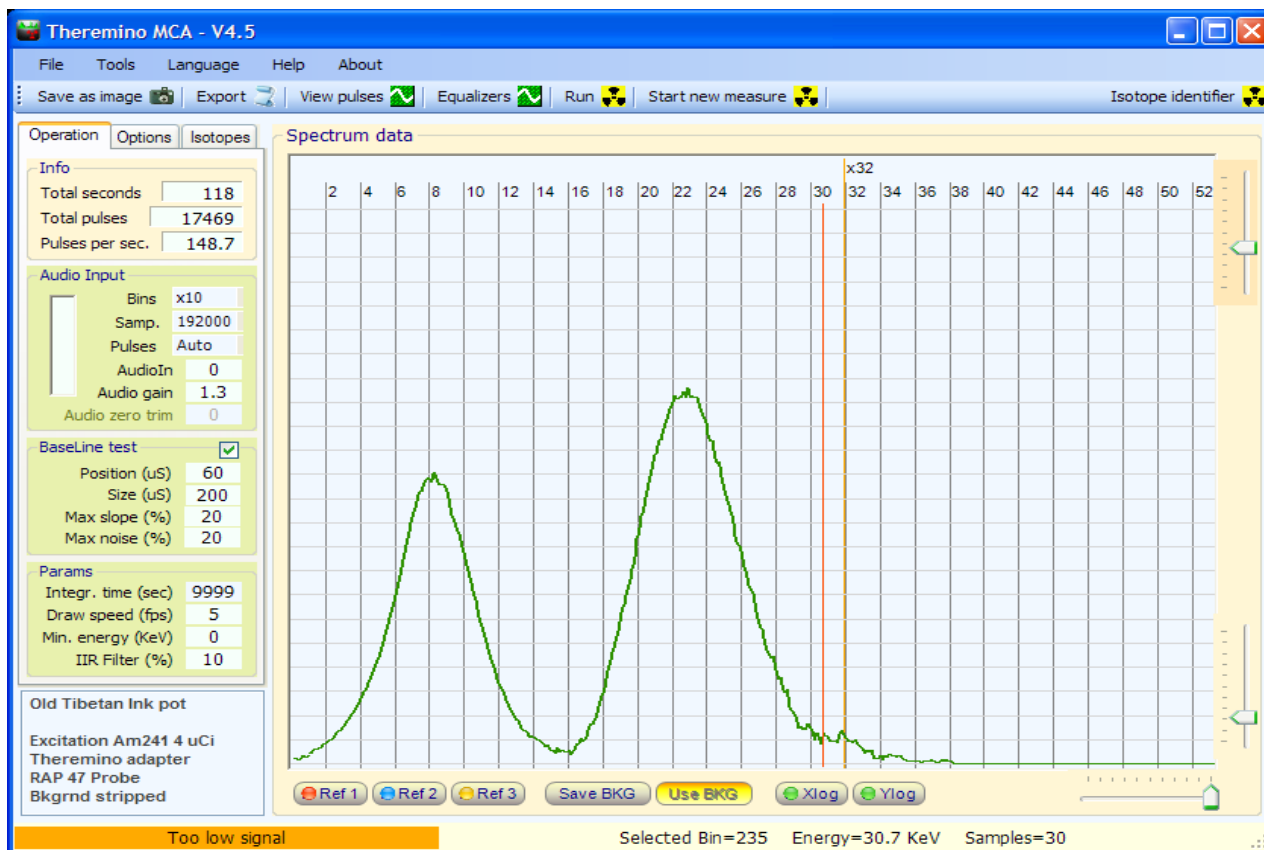
I hope to be in a position to examine other old and uncommon objects in the future and to share the results, of course!
